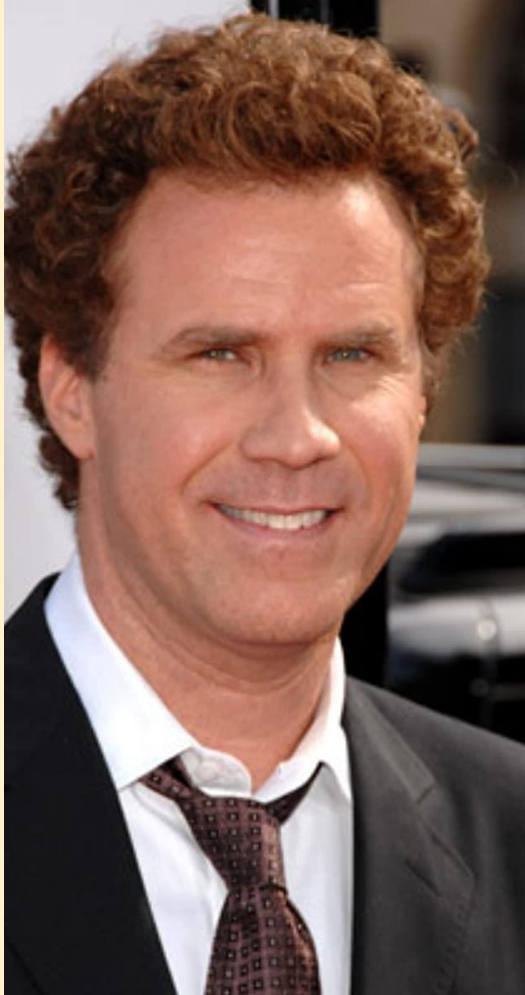


You've got to give this man some credit for continuously making an effort to reach his Spanish-speaking fans.

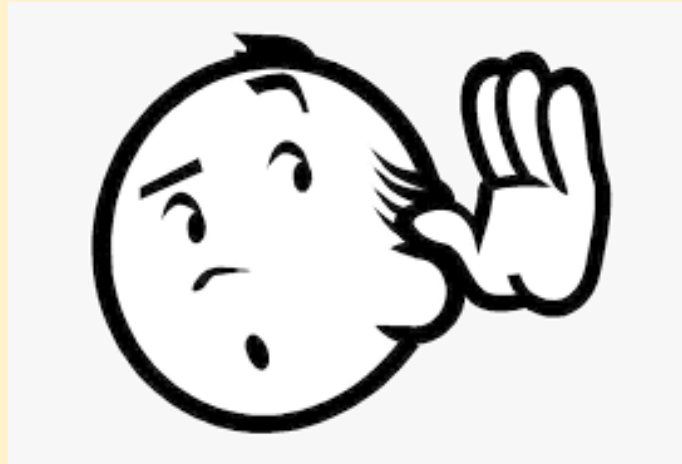
