### **EXAM CONTINGENCY DAY 2022**

The awarding bodies have designated **Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2022** as a 'contingency day' for examinations. This is consistent with the qualification regulators' document Exam system contingency plan: England, Wales and Northern Ireland – [gov.uk/government/publications/exam-system-contingency-plan-england-wales-and-northern-ireland](http://gov.uk/government/publications/exam-system-contingency-plan-england-wales-and-northern-ireland). The designation of a 'contingency day' within the common examination timetable is in the event of national or significant local disruption to examinations in the United Kingdom. It is part of the awarding bodies' standard contingency planning for examinations.
