## Key Word of the Week Serialism

A composition technique where the 12 notes of the chromatic scale are fixed in a certain order. These notes can then only be used in that fixed order and changes are governed by strict rules. This creates much dissonance and interruptions in the music. Total Serialism meant that each element: pitch, tempo, rhythm, dynamics were only used in a specific order.
