Riff

A riff is a short rhythm phrase used in music, that is often played when a soloist is performing or when chords and harmonies are changing.

Examples of songs with famous riffs are: ‘Day Tripper’ by The Beatles, ‘Enter Sandman’ by Metallica, ‘Heartbreaker’ by Led Zeppelin, ‘Iron Man’ by Black Sabbath, ‘Roundabout’ by Yes and ‘Smoke on the Water’ by Deep Purple.
