Anthem

A composition for a choir with English words, used in Anglican and other English-speaking church services. It developed in the mid-16th century in the Anglican Church as a musical form similar to the Roman Catholic motet, a composition for a choir with a sacred Latin text.

Did you know?

Zadok the Priest is a British anthem which was composed by George Frederic Handel for the coronation of King George II in 1727. It is now more commonly known as the music used for the UEFA Champion's League
