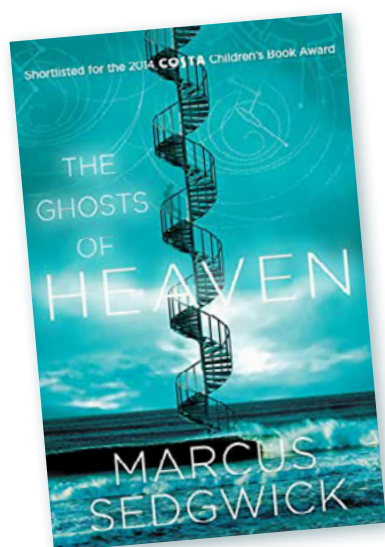
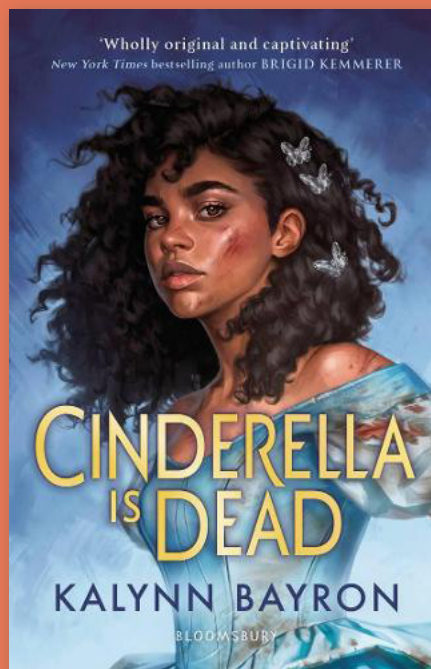


Cinderella is Dead

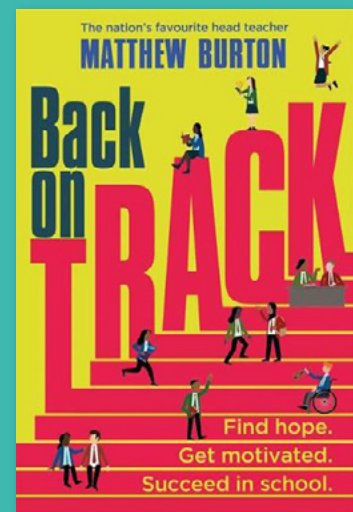
