

THE SCALE OF YOUTH HOMELESSNESS

CENTRE

Centrepoint is the UK's leading youth homelessness charity; we support over 16,000 young people every year and campaign to end youth homelessness by 2037.

Homelessness does not only equal rough sleeping (31%). It could be sofa surfing at friends or family, staying with strangers, sleeping on buses or trains.

What causes youth homelessness?

58% of residents had a family or relationship breakdown

45% are leaving the Care system

28% are Refugees and Asylum Seekers

A YOUNG PERSON FACES HOMELESSNESS EVERY FOUR MINUTES

129,000 young people approached their local authority for help with homelessness in 2021-22. We know the real numbers are significantly higher.



WHAT DO WE PROVIDE?



HOUSING

Manchester – Primarily rough sleepers
Elsewhere – supported housing
accommodation
All with dedicated keyworker staff

HELPLINE

Advice, connect to services, follow ups

HEALTH

Mental & physical, psychotherapy, substance use, relationships

LIFE SKILLS

Financial & Legal support
(Bills, universal credit/
benefits, immigration,
housing, budgeting, cooking)

EDUCATION & EMPLOYMENT

Short courses, traineeships, bursaries, and university, college & job guidance

ACTIVITIES

Sports, Food, Music, Arts (boxing, cooking, poetry, film, painting)

WHERE DO MY DONATIONS GO?

CENTRE POINT

- £5,000 could fund a full course of counselling for 5 homeless young people, ensuring those experiencing a mental health crisis receive vital support
- £2,500 could support 10 young people through our Bursary Scheme, paying for course fees and the essential travel and items needed for an education or training course
- £1,000 could enable our Helpline staff to support up to 35 young people facing homelessness into safe shelter
- £490 could help buy a new laptop and software programs for a college course
- £120 could fund a essential starter pack for arriving at our hostels, ensuring they
 have fresh bedding, towels, toiletries, cooking equipment and winter clothing
- £60 could provide a month's worth of food vouchers
- £5 could help buy travel to get to their college or place of work


