Trio Sonata

The trio sonata was very popular during the Baroque period (roughly 1600–1750). Many Baroque trio sonatas were written for two violins (or recorders, flute or oboe) plus continuo. The continuo part was played by harpsichord (filling in the harmonies) sometimes with the cello playing the bassline.
