Entry Requirements

- A minimum of <u>5 GCSEs at Grade 5 or above</u> (including English and Mathematics).
- A minimum <u>Grade 6 or above</u> in those subjects to be studied at A Level (or in a 'relevant' subject where the subject chosen has not been taken at GCSE).
- Students wishing to study Physics, Chemistry or Biology must have achieved a minimum Grade 6 or higher in GCSE Mathematics.
- Students wishing to study A Level Mathematics should have achieved a GCSE Grade 7 or above.
- If you wish to study two or more science A levels, It is recommended that you can achieve a grade 7/7 in Science dual award or 7 in single sciences.


