All students at Wellington have access to a Level 7 trained **Careers Advisor**, Suzanne Acton. Formal one-to-one meetings take place during Key Stages 4 and 5, but everyone is welcome to drop-in session which are held in the Careers Office every day except Thursday.

Our **Careers Library** is situated in the Careers Office in the Vale building. It contains a wealth of information, leaflets and prospectuses to help students identify the most appropriate providers, courses and pathways available to them.

All students also have access to the **Unifrog** careers platform. This underpins much of our careers programme and is used at strategic points throughout the year by all year groups. All students can access their Unifrog account at all times.
