These rules apply to written exams, coursework and non-exam assessments (NEAs) for this year so are relevant to students in Years 10, 11 and 13.

EXAM DATES FOR SUMMER 2026

Written exams begin on Thursday 7 May (although some Art practical assessments and speaking/listening tests for Languages take place earlier, from April).

The finalised timetable for GCSEs and A-Levels (May/June 2026) is now available on the 'Exam Information' web-page. You will receive an individual statement of entry, giving the days/times of your formal exams, before we break up for Easter.

If you have an exam 'clash' (more than one exam in the same session) I will contact you via Class Charts message with advice and information in the first instance.
